Foundation Certification:

 - Relationship between IT and business: Specific Approaches for Agile, Lean, and ITIL settings.
 - New additions include sustainability, people management, and digital transformation.
 - Application through case studies and hyped scenarios.

The Practitioner examination assumes prerequisite knowledge or equivalent, for example, PRINCE2 Foundation or Project Management Professional (PMP) certification.
